We at BritishBits have taken a cast from a Pre 1939 Mark 1 K6 original telephone box, and created a fibreglass version which has been converted to a Sofa / Lounger. It looks exactly like an original telephone box, only lighter.

Not even Sir Giles Gilbert Scott could have foreseen how iconic a symbol of Britain the red telephone box would become when he was commissioned to design the Kiosk Number 6 to commemorate the Silver Jubilee of King George V.

Although around 60,000 K6's were erected only approximately 13,000 remain on the streets today. The majority of boxes were scrapped or are in the hands of private individuals who use them as "Garden Architecture". The result being that the red telephone box is now a collector's item and very difficult to get hold of... or was...
